Physical and psychological risk factors for ED include:

- health conditions including type 2 diabetes, high blood pressure and high cholesterol
- chronic diseases like renal failure, vascular disease and heart disease
- obesity
- age especially if you're over 50
- alcohol, drug and tobacco use
- mental health conditions like anxiety, depression and stress
- certain medications
- relationship issues



can cause:

- low sperm count, which can affect fertility
- an enlarged prostate, which can makes it hard to urinate
- acne
- weight gain
- mood swings and irritability



can cause:

- loss of body and facial hair
- decreased muscle mass
- low sex drive
- poor concentration
- weak bones

If you're concerned about ED, talk to your doctor. You may have an underlying condition that needs to be diagnosed. Your doctor may want to explore ED treatments including:

- prescription medications
- hormone replacement therapy
- lifestyle changes to improve your heart and vascular health
- mental health care







If you have any of these symptoms or are worried about your testosterone level, see your doctor. They can give you a simple blood test to check your level and determine the right treatment.
